This Vocational Program offers a range of courses to eligible students for the entire period of time they need to engage in learning to satisfy mandatory schooling requirements until age 17. We do not just offer one course; we offer a pathway to employment or further education.

The vocational program is funded by Smart and Skilled and is an approved program for early school leavers. Those wishing to swap the RoSA pathway for a vocational pathway to achieve a certificate II or III. The program requires students to be signed out of school. Students are leaving school by enrolling in this program.

Delivered in a real work environment, this training aims to bring learning to life, encouraging students to strive for a future that includes employment, building important skills for a future career in the automotive service and repair industry or the construction industry.

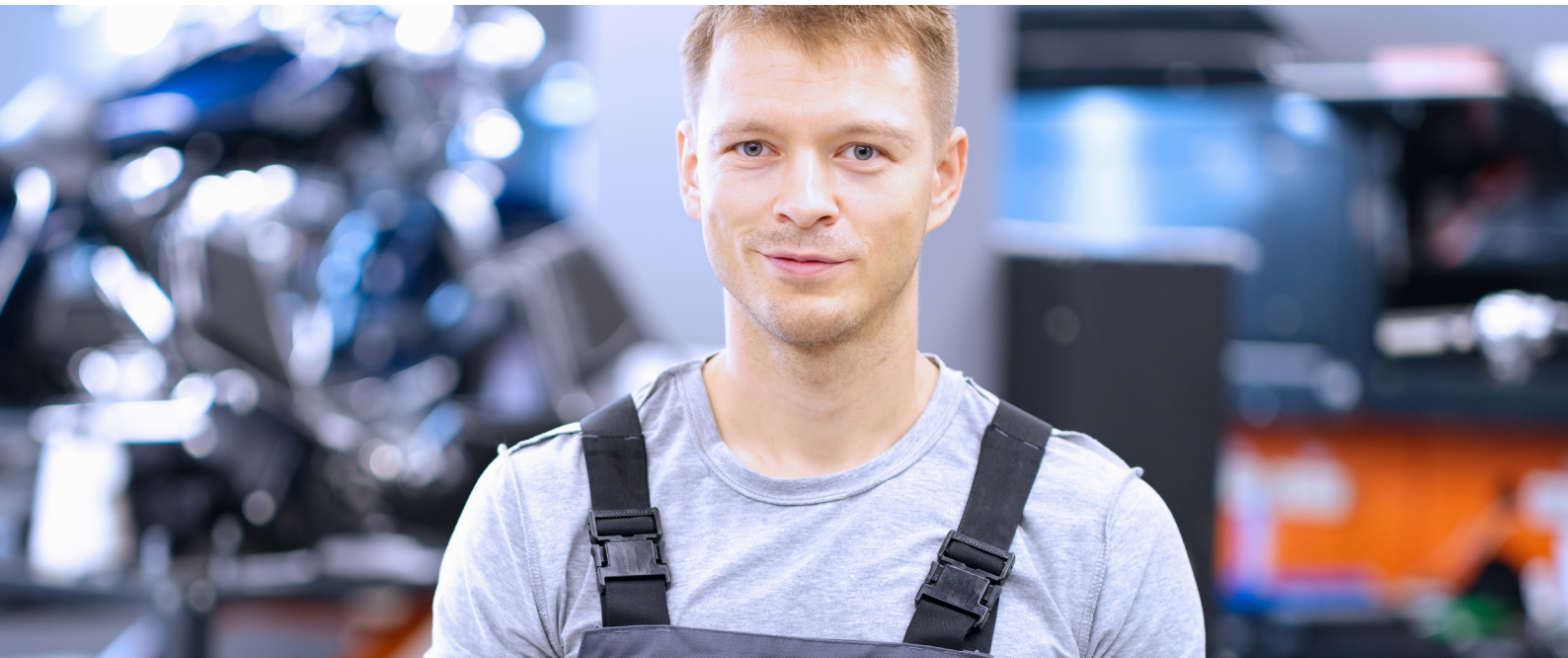
